

Camping at Boomhuis:

Congratulations, you just made the best decision for the day by downloading our Boomhuis PDF, so well done, mooi man, mooi!

What can be better than camping under the Milky Way?

Wild Camping at Boomhuis is one of the most spectacular features of the West coast.

Some basic information about the 3 Boomhuis Wild Campsites:

- The sites are exclusive and secluded, you will need to book in advance.
- 1st Camp site can accommodate up to 4 vehicles max of 8 people
- 2nd Camp site, up to 2 vehicles max of 6 people.
- 3rd Camp site, 1 vehicle max of 4 people.

Boomhuis offers

1x composting toilet per camp site, as well as a small washing station.

A water tank with some extra water for washing at the entrance of Boomhuis (Not suitable for drinking).

You can get extra drinking water from town, just a short drive away from Boomhuis.

Braai & fire, **bring your own fire extinguisher.**

You are only allowed to make fire in the designated area at the camp or in your own enclosed braai.

Make fires away from any bushes or grass.

Do not make any open fires when it's windy. Rather use charcoal or a weber.

If a veld fire occurs because of your actions, you will be liable to all

damages that we and the veld suffers because of this.

We do have wood available, please specify in advance should you need wood, wood price will be confirmed upon booking.

This is **100% off grid**. There is no phone signal or electricity or running water at the camp site, only basic Compost Toilet and a Water Tank for washing.

You need to bring whatever you need to be self-sufficient. Drinking Water, Outdoor Shower, Braai, trash bags etc.

Bring a fire extinguisher. Remember to leave the spot as you have found it.

You need to take everything back with you including your trash. An arrangement can be made in advance to bring the trash to the main Plaas Huis).

No pooping or emptying the toilet bucket anywhere on the property.

Littering and human waste or damage to the veld will be fined.

Be very careful with open flames.

What to pack for your Boomhuis camping adventure:

- The usual gear – tents, sleeping bags, cooking utensils, food, emergency supplies and a firstaid kit
- Binoculars - for tracking down those untamed creatures
- Toilet paper – always handy, in allsorts of emergencies
- Hand sanitizer - it can be difficult to find clean water or facilities in some places
- Something for campsite fun – like balls, kites, frisbees etc. especially when travelling with kids

- Insect repellent - for those buzzing and flying annoyances.
- Books and magazines - for when relaxing under a tree
- Water, water, water – rather too much than too little. Remember, Koekenaap is a semi- desert country
- Rope – use it to pull your car out of a patch of thick sand or even as an emergency washing lin
- Sunscreen – with Koekenaap's ample sunshine, it's always a good move to cover u
- Locks and protective covering for your valuables - holiday stories are just not the same when the camera disappears halfway down the line
- Spare tyres – you can never be too careful
- A relaxed mood - The wild open spaces of Groenvlei Plaas are best enjoyed by unwinding and allowing the awe-inspiring views to sink in properly.

Remember to drive slowly and keep an eye out for the smaller treasures of the land – a beautiful desert succulent, a curious chameleon, or a colony of graaitjies.

There is invariably more than meets the eye.

- Leave the spot exactly as you found it. You will be fined up to R1000 for any trash, damage to veld, litter, human waste, or anything found out of place.
